The workshop started with a basic understanding of web, how can one access the information from the web, url, search engines with their working, simple and advance search and invisible web. After clearing the basic concepts of web, the insights of the simple web searching techniques were given to students. These simple techniques included keyword searching and the methods to reduce the number of search results, specific website searching and

searching page titles. Then the students were briefed about the tools that google provides like the google images, google calculator, google glossary etc. After that the students were told how to do intitle searching in page titles and urls. Searching a specific type of file on a particular website was also demonstrated. The event concluded with the practical implementation and queries from the students.

There were approximately 40 participants from Management, Law and Engineering Schools of Mody University. The students showed great enthusiasm in attending the workshop.

This indicates that it is definitely time to revisit civility and courtesy in all or interactions, both personal and professional.
