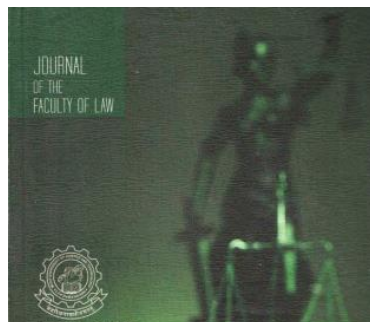
1. 'Journal of the faculty of law'

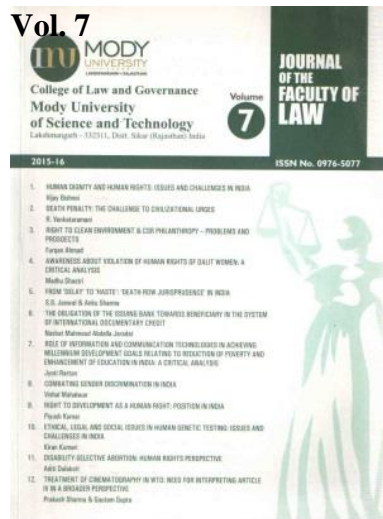

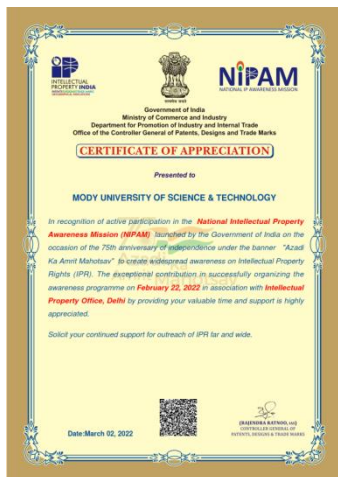
