Examination Notification (for UG, PG and Ph.D. Students)

In view of the present Pandemic situation, University decided the promotion criteria for UG and PG students (Except Final Year students) in the last academic session 2019-20, in Spring semester, the Chairman of Academic Council (36th meeting of academic council, dated 18/9/2020) considered the same recommendations as adopted for the academic session 2020-21, spring semester (Except Final Year students) and decided that:

1. For Theory Papers:

Grading of the students for theory end term examinations to be composite of 50% marks on the basis of the internal evaluation/ assessment and the remaining 50% marks on the basis of performance in previous semester (i.e. CGPA) only (Annexure-I).

2. In addition to the above, If a student wishes to improve her score in a particular course, she may be allowed to appear in that course along with next End Term Exams (to be held in Dec 2021/Jan 2022), **subject to the following condition:**

- **Whatever marks/grades she will obtain in the said “improvement exam” will be treated as final marks/Grades. The Examination would be of 100 Marks.**
- **There will be no consideration of internal marks in case of improvement exam (100 marks paper).**

3. For Practical Papers:

- Grading of the **Engineering students for Practical end term examinations** to be composite of 60% marks on the basis of the internal evaluation/ assessment and the remaining 40% marks on the basis of performance in previous semester (i.e. CGPA) only (Annexure-II).
- Grading of the students for Practical end term examinations (Other than Engineering Students) to be composite of 50% marks on the basis of the internal evaluation/ assessment and the remaining 50% marks on the basis of performance in previous semester (i.e. CGPA) only (Annexure-II).

4. **Major Projects/ Dissertation/Industrial Internships/Summer Internship Projects :**

Students will submit their report in any of the following ways: Soft copy in the PDF form/ Physical (hard copy) once they join the University.

Project viva-voce to be conducted simultaneously at one go, by a team of faculty members nominated by HOD of the Department and Dean of the School, through online tool and to be completed by 20th July, 2021.

5. The Students to be given full attendance (i.e. period of lockdown during which online teaching continued). The actual attendance will be attendance in regular mode plus attendance in online mode/lockdown period. In case the actual attendance falls short of 75%, it is to be treated as 75 % so that no student is detained in the prevailing conditions.

6. Marks as obtained in the Mid Term Examination (MTE) to be considered as internal Marks. In case, a student has not appeared in the MTE, the marks to be awarded based on online/offline assignment (as per our rules of Re-Exams).

7. The Internal assessment of practical's of the students, if remaining to be conducted by the concerned teacher through online tool from 1st July to 10th July, 2021.

8. The Seminars of the students, if remaining to be conducted by the concerned teacher through online tool from 1st July to 10th July, 2021.

9. For the Terminal Semesters Students:

- Those students who have back papers in their previous semesters may be arranged supplementary examination in online mode.
- Those students who already applied for spring semester back paper examinations will be conducted in the month of July 12-30, 2021, through online mode.

10. Second Window Examination for 1st Year UG and PG (Autumn Semester, 2020-21)

1st Year Students (UG/PG) who were absent in the main End Term Examination held in March, 2021 due to Pandemic Situation, the second window exam will be conducted in the month of July 12-25, 2021, through online mode.

11. PhD Course Work Examination

PhD is the highest degree of academic in order to maintain the quality and standards. PhD course work examination will be conducted offline mode only.

Those Students who were absent in the PhD course work End Term Examination held in March, 2021 due to Pandemic Situation, the second window examination will be held in offline mode as soon as the pandemic situation is appropriate.
