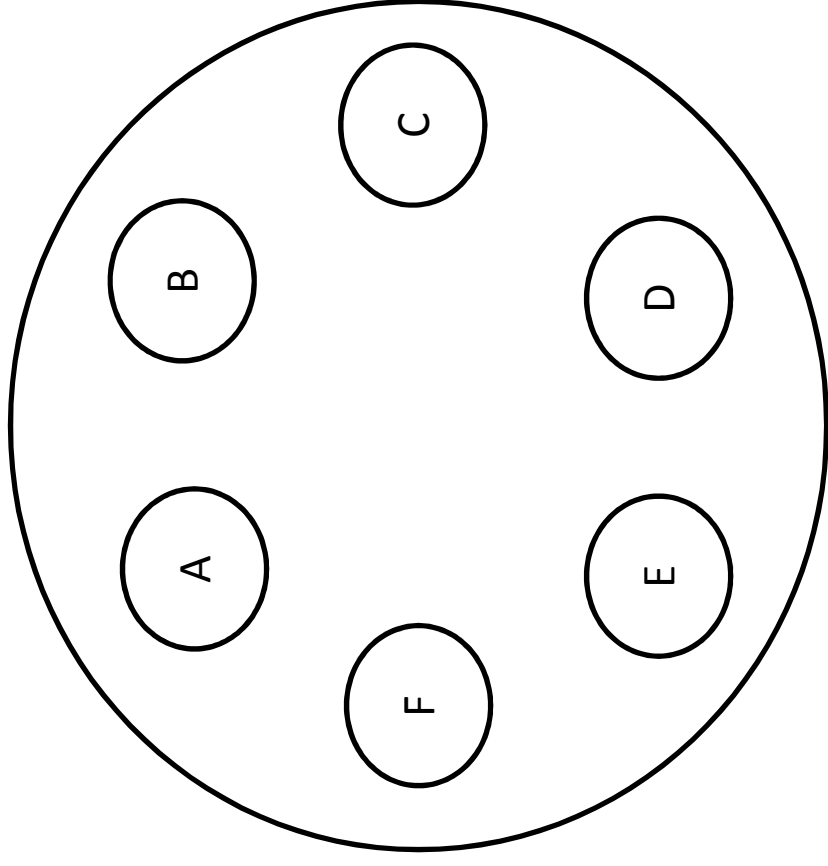

Career

The word "Career" means an occupation undertaken for a significant period of a person's life and with opportunities for progress.

Why Plan your Career?

- Your career affects 2/3 of your life.



- Your career generates up to 3.5 crore in lifetime earnings with Graduate/PG degrees.



- Your career affects your identity as a person.



- Your career affects your physical & mental well-being.



The Value of Not Planning

- The nicest thing about *not planning* is that failure comes as a complete surprise and is preceded by a period of worry and depression.
- We should understand and be knowing that what is happening around us, where we are naturally inclined, what are our natural capabilities.
- In short, this much “Consciousness” is required before making THE MOST important decision of our life.

Career planning 4 step planning process

- **Knowing Yourself:** Skills, likes/dislikes and values
- **Finding Out:** Exploring what is out there
- **Making Decisions:** Comparing options
- **Taking Action:** Working towards your goals

Step 1: knowing yourself

- Begin by asking yourself the following questions:
 - *Where am I at now?*
 - *Where do I want to be?*
 - *What do I want out of a job or career?*
 - *What do I like to do?*
 - *What are my strengths?*
 - *What is important to me?*
- At the end of this step you will have a clearer idea of your work or learning goal and your individual preferences.
- You can use this information about yourself as your personal 'wish list' against which you can compare all the information you gather in Step 2: **finding out**.
- Your personal preferences are very useful for helping you choose your best option at this point in time, which you can do in Step 3: **making decisions**.

Step 2: finding out

- This step is about exploring the occupations and learning areas that interest you. Once you have some idea of your occupational preferences you can research the specific skills and qualifications required for those occupations.
- *Explore occupations that interest you and ask yourself how do my skills and interests match up with these occupations?*
 - *Where are the gaps?*
 - *What options do I have to gain these skills or qualify for these occupations?*
 - *What skills do I need?*
 - *Where is the work?*
- At the end of this step you will have a list of preferred occupations and/or learning options.

Step 3: making decisions

- This step involves comparing your options, narrowing down your choices and thinking about what suits you best at this point in time. Ask yourself:
 - *What are my best work/training options?*
 - *How do they match with my skills, interests and values?*
 - *How do they fit with the current labour market?*
 - *How do they fit with my current situation and responsibilities?*
 - *What are the advantages and disadvantages of each option?*
 - *What will help and what will hinder me?*
 - *What can I do about it?*
- At the end of this step you will have narrowed down your options and have more of an idea of what you need to do next to help you achieve your goals.

Step 4: taking action

- Here you plan the steps you need to take to put your plan into action.
- Use all you have learnt about your skills, interests and values together with the information you have gathered about the world of work to create your plan. Begin by asking yourself:
 - *What actions/steps will help me achieve my work, training and career goals?*
 - *Where can I get help?*
 - *Who will support me?*
- At the end of this step you will have: a plan to help you explore your options further (e.g. work experience, or more research); or a plan which sets out the steps to help you achieve your next learning or work

Mistakes to Avoid When Selecting a Career

- Listening to People Who Tell You That You Should, or Should Not, Do Something
- Following in Someone Else's Footsteps
- Not Doing Your Homework
- Not Talking to Those in the Know
- Going for the Money
- Ignoring Who You Are
- Not Considering Location, Location, Location
- Ignoring the Future: While you shouldn't make your choice solely on an occupation's appearance on a "best careers list," to ignore employment outlook is careless.

Why Psychometric Test?

- Psychological test is "an objective and standardized measure of a sample of behavior"
- A score on a well-constructed test is believed to reflect a psychological construct such as achievement in a school subject, cognitive ability, aptitude, emotional functioning, personality, etc.
- Differences in test scores are thought to reflect individual differences in the construct the test is supposed to measure. The technical term for the science behind psychological testing is psychometrics

Why Psychometric Test?

- The field is concerned with the objective measurement of

Skills

knowledge

abilities,

attitudes

personality traits

educational achievement

- Some psychometric researchers focus on the construction and validation of assessment instruments such as questionnaires, tests, raters' judgments, and personality tests.

Why MBT Test?

- Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI) is an introspective self-report questionnaire with the purpose of indicating differing *psychological preferences* in how people *perceive the world* around them and *make decisions*
- It can be of great help in early consideration
- To be further supported by Big Five Personality Test, as well as RIASEC Test (Holland Types - occupational interest) etc.
- To be further supplemented with skills test

Why MBT Test?

The **Myers Briggs Type Indicator** is a **tool** or **framework** for understanding our own Personality Type and that of others.

- It is an **indicator**, **not a test** so there are **no right or wrong answers**
- It looks at normal behaviour
- It identifies **preferences** rather than competencies, abilities or skills.

Remember...there is no better or worse Personality Type to be!

THE FOUR DIMENSIONS OF TYPE PREFERENCES ARE NOT ABSOLUTES: EVERYONE USES ALL EIGHT

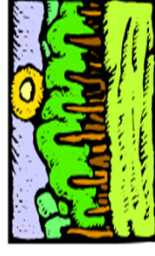

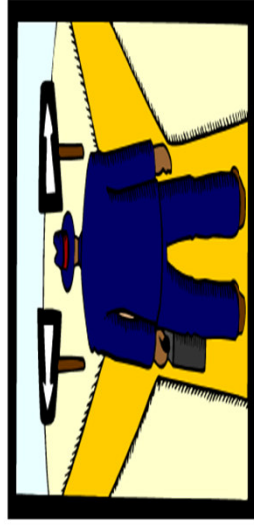

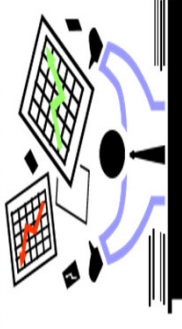

Extravert - Introvert



- E – People, activity, talking (external world)
 - Readily takes initiative
 - “Act first, think later”
 - Enjoys a wide variety and change in people and relationships
 - Very approachable
 - Develop ideas through discussion
- I – Thoughts, feelings, writing (internal world)
 - Think/reflect first, then act
 - Needs “private” time to reflect
 - One-on-one relationship or conversations
 - Great listeners
 - Enjoys focusing on a project

Sensing (S) – Intuitive (N)



- S – Facts – real & tangible - now
 - Carefully thought out conclusions
 - Lives in the present
 - “Do something” rather than “think about it”
 - Fantasy is a dirty word
 - Common sense solutions
- N – Possibilities – Inspiration - future
 - Use personal feelings to make decisions
 - Comfortable with fuzzy data
 - Inventing new possibilities is automatic
 - Sometimes considered absent-minded

Thinking (T) - Feeling (F)

- T – Decision through logic and truth
 - More important to be right than liked
 - Viewed as unemotional
 - Focus on tasks
 - Provides objective and critical analysis
- F - Decision through emotion
 - Follow hunch to make quick conclusions
 - Sensitive to feelings of others
 - Toxic reaction to disharmony, prefer to accommodate
 - Takes things too personally



Judging (J) - Perceiving (P)

J – planned, orderly, reach closure quickly

- Get things done
- Punctual
- Likes to use a list, make plans
- Structure and order
- Works best and avoids stress when keeps ahead of deadlines and not given too much information at one time



• P – flexible, spontaneous, stay open

- Lives for the moment
- Works well under pressure and deadlines
- Creative
- Multitasks
- Avoids commitments, it interferes with flexibility

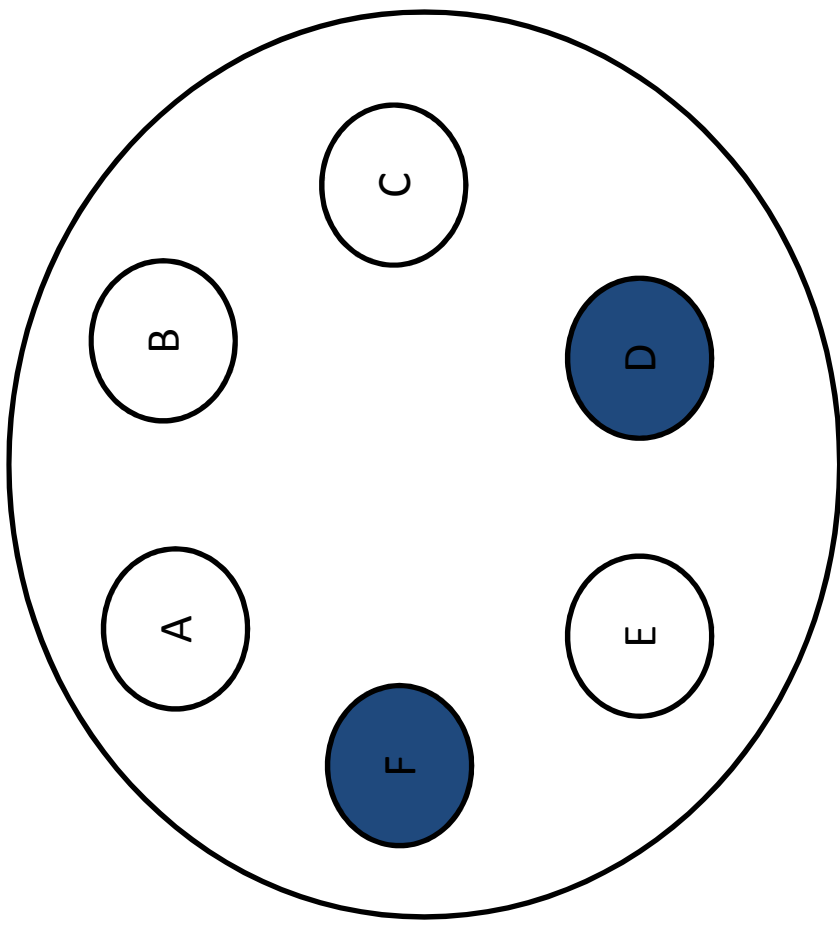
