## Parliament Visit





The workshop provided students with practical insights into advocacy techniques, legal research, persuasive argumentation, and courtroom strategies, equipping them with essential skills for competitive mooting and professional practice.

## Central library



The Central Library at Mody University houses over 64,948 volumes and 13,545 e-books encompassing Engineering, Science, Technology, Management, Law, Fashion Design, and Architecture. Students access international legal journals, databases, research repositories, and digital resources. The library provides modern study spaces, computer facilities, and research assistance. Dedicated sections for legal research materials include case laws, statutes, and legal commentaries, serving as an invaluable resource for academic excellence.

## Inter School Debate Competition





A Sewage Treatment Plant is commissioned to recycle 11 lakh liters of used water daily, and use it for horticulture.
