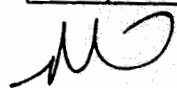

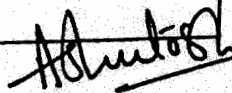


Agenda & Minutes

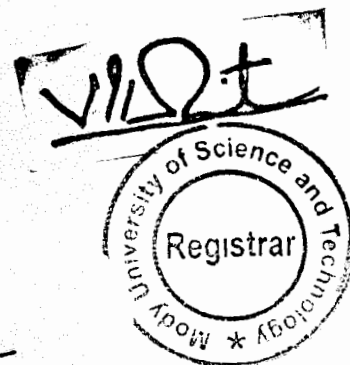
