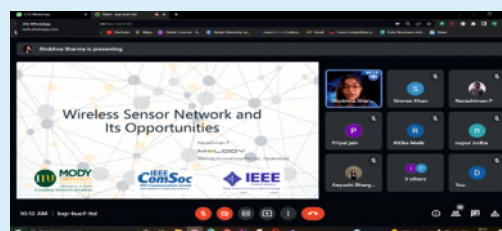

WSN and it's Opportunities

We learned about the key skills for working in WSN and its areas of research. A case study on "OpenThread" released by Google was also explained and we got to know about OpenThread stimulation through it. The attendees got to acquire skills and knowledge and the webinar ended with a solution to the queries of students.



School of Engineering and Technology : Orientation



Student Induction Programme of SET was conducted in MUST. School of Liberal Arts and Sciences : Orientation

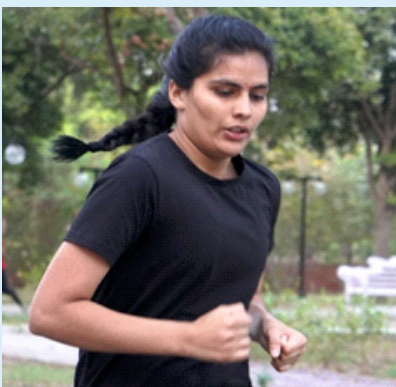


sacred prasad at the Annapurna Bhavan Dining Hall.

Visit To Central Women's Jail, Jaipur



On September 24, 2022, students from Mody University paid a visit to the Central Women's Jail in Jaipur. 82 students in all were present, along with 4 teachers. To analyze the jail's circumstances, the inmates' way of life, and the problems they confront, the visit's goal was to get to know the prisoners. A questionnaire was given to the students, which they were instructed to complete based on what they had seen in the jail. Dr. Rohit Soni, Ms. Navna Singh, Ms. Pooja Singh, and Ms. Sangeeta Jakhar were the teachers that visited along with the students.

There was a total of 110 inmates, out of which 25 were under rigorous imprisonment, 2 were under simple imprisonment, 76 with cases under trial, and 7 were foreigners. The inmates coexisted peacefully, they completed all of their jobs on time, and the jail was maintained exceptionally clean and hygienic, according to the students' observations. Balanced food is given to the inmates. They have access to exceptional medical facilities, and a doctor is always on call for them. Every 15 days, they receive the toiletries. The atmosphere in the jail was fairly calm, and they were provided with appropriate sanitary supplies. Along with services like salons and drama theatres, they are given access to adequate educational facilities that will enable them to lead better lives after their sentence in prison is complete. The IGNOU offers degrees to inmates who seek to continue their education, and later inmates themselves instruct the illiterate inmates in the prison. For three months, the prisoners take chances of doing the mess duties. On alternate Sundays, they are served with kheer and halwa, and special meals are prepared for festivals. Every festival is celebrated within the prison.

Despite a few complaints about the delay by government advocates, they are given appropriate legal assistance. If convicted, inmates get 15 days to see their families; if they are on trial, they have 7 days. In the phone booth built within the jail itself, they can speak to their family on call every day for five minutes. By keeping them occupied with academics and activities like dancing, viewing cartoons, etc., the wrong influence that may come upon the children living in jail is countered.

It is also important to note that the jail operates under the slogan "Road to reform" which is entirely consistent with the Indian legal system's emphasis on reformation rather than punitive measures. Undoubtedly, the experience was quite informative and enlightening. The children learned a lot from it and were excited to see the parts of the jail that the general public is unaware of. They also gave credit to the Indian judicial system and the jail staff for maintaining the facility in good shape.
